- *(Greg Satterfield):*
 - *RMP, Working with Sasol group to do a exercise maybe June or July timeframe not for sure yet.*

III. New Projects: (Gerald Pullin)

➤ **LNG:**

1. Delphin:

- *FID Q4 2022*

2. LC LNG:

- *Energy Transfer signed two additional delivery contracts making a total of 3 contracts now signed.*
- *LC LNG is fully permitted and FID Q4 2022 is very likely*

3. Commonwealth:

- *Has contracted 100% of capacity making it \$4.5 Billion.*
- *FID in Q3 2022 very likely.*

4. Venture:

- *CP #2 under construction. Kiewit*

5. Cameron LNG/Sempra

- *Three companies, Bechtel, Kiewit, and Zachary are all bidding for unit #4.*
- *Anticipate 10,000 construction workers*

6. Driftwood:

- *Bechtel mobilized on site April with a “limited authorization to proceed” on construction of units 1 & 2 of a planned 5 unit facility.*
- *All 5 units are fully permitted and are waiting for FID for full construction of units 1 & 2 by Q4 2022.*
- *Anticipate 6,500 construction workers at peak.*

7. Golden Pass:

- *3 additional trains under construction.*
- *Anticipating hiring 7,000 construction workers.*

8. Magnolia LNG:

- *Is fully permitted and was issued authorization to export LNG by US government.*
- *Anticipate FID to construct Q4.*

➤ **Alternate Energy:**

1. **State of Louisiana** – *offshore wind farm out of Houma.*
2. **Solar wind farm** *2500 acres West of Beaumont near China, Texas.*
3. **Bio Jet fuel Bon Wier** *Q2 2023.*

➤ **Chemical Plants:**

1. **Chevron Orange** – *announcement by Q1 2022. W T Ballard Civil site prep on going.*
2. **OCI Beaumont** - *\$5B expansion with Jacob’s as EPC.*

➤ **US Corps of Engineers:**

1. *\$4B levee construction from Sabine River to Galveston.*

➤ **Pipelines:**

1. **Enable** – *Lina, LA to Golden Pass. Pipeline and compressor stations.*
2. *Compressor station near Starks, LA.*
